From Washington National Airport

By DC Metro Take the Yellow Line to L'Enfant Plaza. Transfer to the Green Line to the College Park Station. Once at the metro station, call Silver Cab 301-277-6000. The cab fare should be about \$10.

By Super Shuttle

Call (800) BLUE VAN (800-258-3826) to arrange a direct ride from the airport to the hotel. It should cost about \$29 per person.

From Baltimore Washington Airport

By Train

Amtrak (www.amtrak.com, 800-USA-RAIL/800-872-7245) Take the train to the New Carrollton Metro Station. Once at the metro station, call Silver Cab 301-277-6000. The cab fare should be about \$20.

Marc Train (From Baltimore to Washington, DC, *Monday through Friday only*) (800-325-RAIL)

- Take the Camden Line to College Park Metro Station. (Get the schedule here: <u>http://mta.maryland.gov/services/marc/schedulesSystemMaps/camden.cfm</u>) Once at the metro station, call Silver Cab 301-277-6000. From College Park Metro Station, it's about a \$10 cab fare.

To Hotel by Car

Set your GPS or use Google Maps to get to 3501 University Blvd, East, Hyattsville, Maryland, 20783. Parking is \$8 per day at the hotel.

To Conference Site by Metro

Take the Red Line train (toward Glenmont); transfer at the Fort Totten station to the Green Line train (toward Greenbelt); get off at the College Park/U of MD station.

Or take the Green Line train (toward Greenbelt); get off at the College Park/U of MD station.

Take the University Shuttle-UM bus (East side of the Metro station). Shuttle-UM service between the College Park Station and the main campus is every 8 minutes peak hours most weekdays, is offered year-round, and is open to everyone - no ID required.

The best lots to park in for proximity to the conference are:

- Union Lane Garage Located between the Adele H. Stamp Student Union Center for Campus Life and Cole Field House. Hours of operation are 7:00a.m. to 2:00 a.m. daily. Current rates at this facility are \$3.00 per hour, with a \$15.00 per day maximum and a \$5 per day maximum on Saturday and Sunday.
- **Mowatt Lane Garage** Located near Van Munching Hall and the Robert H. Smith School of Business. Three hundred fifty parking spaces within this facility are allocated for

visitor parking on the **top level of the garage**. The hours of operation, as a digital pay station facility, are 7:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. daily. Parking rates for this facility are \$3.00 per hour, with a \$15.00 per day maximum and a \$5 per day maximum on Saturday and Sunday.

• **Regents Drive Garage** – Located near Hornbake Library, the Plant Science, Physics and Chemistry buildings. A small number of visitor parking spaces are available on the south (Fieldhouse Drive) entrance. Hours of operation are 7:00a.m. to 2:00 a.m. daily. Current rates at this facility are \$3.00 per hour, with a \$15.00 per day maximum and a \$5 per day maximum on Saturday and Sunday.
